## CAMP KIT LIST

*Please mark everything with child's name and Scout Group so it can be returned if found.*

- Uniform – Wear when travelling to and from site
- Rucksack / Large holdall – to put everything in
- Small / Day Rucksack – To take when hiking / out for the day
- Strong plastic bag for clean clothes (tents and bags can leak)
- Bag for dirty clothes
- Underwear
- Socks
- Shirts/tee shirts
- Night wear – Tee shirt and shorts are best in summer
- Shorts/trousers – Jeans and track suits take a long time to dry
- Swimming costume
- Jumper/jacket/fleece – Even summer evenings can be cool
- Sleeping bag – Sleeping bags should always be wrapped in a thick polythene bag which wraps around several times and tied up, not a rubbish sack, they tear too easily
- Roll mat – to stay warm
- Cake – to be handed in and shared out at meal/break times
- **Wash Kit**
  - Large towel – For washing and swimming
  - Flannel, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb
  - Personal hygiene products as required
  - Hankies/tissues
  - Medication (must be included on camp information form and handed in)
- **Activity Gear**
  - Waterproof jacket & Trousers
  - Boots or strong shoes – for walking and chopping wood
  - Training shoes/plimsolls
  - Sunscreen
  - Hat
  - Water bottle
  - Old clothes for climbing etc.
- **Odds and Ends**
  - Torch & batteries
  - Note book/paper & pencil
  - Camp blanket or jacket if you have one
  - Pen knife (if you have one) – must be handed in at the beginning of camp

### Do NOT Bring

- Aerosols, matches, lighters, or any other flammable liquid or gas – These are dangerous and not necessary. Any found will be confiscated and not returned
- Anything valuable or electronic – No iPods, mp3 players, computers, mobile phones, Portable TVs, Camcorders etc. They are too easily stolen or damaged.
